Every programme of God speaks loudest at the end; better is the end of a matter than the beginning thereof. Thanksgiving acknowledges that it is a divine privilege to be alive and well. We must never take God for granted. When you are addicted to Thanksgiving the heavens opens up to you on its own accord, 1 Peter 3:13.
