## Subject: Chapel Service Date: Tuesday, November 15, 2016 Minister: Pastor Charles Ihekwaba Message: Wisdom from Above Makes High Fliers (Part 3) - Genesis 41: 38 - 44

The importance of divine wisdom can never be over emphasised; it has been established that wisdom is a vital requirement for riding the waves of glory (Pro. 3 vs. 35; 1 Cor. 2 vs. 7). The word of God is God's wisdom bank (Psalm 19 vs. 7 - 9). The word of God is God's wisdom in print (John 1 vs. 1 – 3). Jesus Christ is the word of God; He is also the wisdom and power of God (1 Corinthians 1 vs. 24).

The wisdom from the word of God is superior to every other wisdom (1 Corinthians 1 vs. 25; 2 Corinthians 13 vs. 8; Isaiah 55 vs. 9 – 11). Every word of God is powerful enough to accomplish the purpose for which it was sent.

Everyone that celebrates divine wisdom ends up being celebrated. Luke 2 vs. 47; Matthew 13 vs. 54; John 1 vs. 14 - The proof of divine wisdom is as seen in the ministry of Jesus; always commanding unusual results.

## HOW DOES THE WORD OF GOD MAKES WISE?

Access to the word of God and practice of same is the gateway to the wisdom of God. When this wisdom of God is at work in one's life, it makes such individual a commander of accomplishment (2 Timothy 3 vs. 15).

- Through a studious life style; that is, rubbing your mind with the mind of the only wise God (2 Corinthians 3 vs. 18; 2 Timothy 2 vs. 15; 1 Timothy 4 vs. 13 - 15). Spiritual principles are corner stone principles that when applied to real life issues deliver unusual results. Daniel 9 vs. 2 Proverbs 1 vs. 5.
- Through fasting, one encounters striking revelations (Isaiah 58 vs. 8; Isaiah 60 vs. 1 3; Psalm 119 vs. 30). This is an avenue for dealing with your flesh and feeding your spirit man.
- 3. Through practical application of the word (Matthew 7 vs. 24 25). Wisdom is knowing the right thing and doing them (Deuteronomy 4 vs. 5 6; Deuteronomy 6 vs. 3). Whatever you discover from the pages of scriptures and consciously apply to your daily life, are enough to make you a show piece for the world to see.
- 4. God's wisdom guarantees success in academics (Proverbs 24 vs. 3 5; Daniel 1 vs. 17, 20; Deuteronomy 28 vs. 1; Proverbs 10 vs. 9).

Every act of unrighteousness places a question mark on an individual's integrity, while integrity places honour and glory on you (Psalm 45 vs. 4; Psalm 26 vs. 1 - 2). Integrity guides and preserves man's destiny; God is committed to always blessing the upright.

1 John 5 vs. 17; Daniel 1 vs. 8; Romans 6 vs. 13 – As scholars, it should be conscious to all that every form of examination misconduct is a sin which has the capacity to disconnect one from the grace that guarantees success in the race of life.
