Theme: Godliness: Covenant Gateway to Greatness (Part 2)

There are gates to be lifted for anyone's all-round breakthrough to be established, and until the gate is lifted access will continue to be denied. To gain access through any gate, a key is needed; it is the key that makes thoroughfare easy. It is important to discover the key that gets every door open, and in this case the Master Key is the key of godliness (1 Timothy 4 vs. 8).

Godliness engenders greatness; without godliness, the quest for greatness will be nothing but a mirage. Greatness is a reward for embracing godliness (Daniel 1 vs. 8, 17). When a man dwells in sin, his destiny is bound to sink. Destiny does not stand any chance where sin prevails (Romans 1 vs. 28). There is an enthronement for any man who refuses to subscribe to a life of sin.

Greatness is man's heritage in redemption (Joshua 1 vs. 8), and good success is rooted in Christ. Anything outside of Christ will end up in doom and waste. Without God, there is no success (Luke 1 vs. 30 - 31). Jesus is the gateway to greatness as ordinance for the redeemed by God (Galatians 3 vs. 13 - 14).

WHAT ARE THE FORCES OF UNGODLINESS THAT HINDER GREATNESS?

- 1. The spirit of disobedience will hinder anyone from attaining greatness (Ephesians 2 vs. 1 2).
- 2. A lying spirit will cut short destiny and put one to shame (1 Kings 22 vs. 22 23). God cannot do anything great for people that live in lies.

HOW TO OVERCOME UNGODLINESS

- 1. Recognize that the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of holiness. Be hungry and thirsty for godliness (Isaiah 41 vs. 17).
- 2. Consciously put on godly habits. It takes godly habit to fight ungodly habit (Colossians 3 vs. 10 12). Godliness requires a conscious effort to live and walk godly.

BENEFIT OF GODLINESS

1. You have unfettered and unhindered access to fresh unction (Ecclesiastes 9 vs. 8; Psalm 45 vs. 6 - 7).
