

How to Put the Word to Work

The future belongs to those who obey the word of God. If you're not a doer of God's word, there's no future for you, (James 1:22-25). When you hear the word of God and not put them to work, you're not ready for any kind of advancement.

The word of God is God's miracle bank. It can be very frustrating having money in the bank and not be able to access it. The same way we store our money in a bank is the same way that God's word is a bank of miracles, (Mathew 8:8); only the spoken word guarantees healing.

There's healing, turnaround and breakthroughs in the word of God, (Psalm 107:20). The word of God makes the difference, when you move at the instance of the word, you record unquestionable miracles, (Luke 5:4-6).

Excuses will never guarantee success. You must stop the excuses; those who give excuses are excused out of life. Every outstanding feat in life comes with obedience to God's word, (John 9:10). It doesn't matter how much information you have, until you apply it, it cannot change your situation, (Psalm 119:97-100). You must put the word of God to work.

What to Do to Put God's Word to Work

Prayer - Engage the platform of prayer for a turnaround encounter. It takes a call to receive an answer, (Jeremiah 33:3). Until you pray, you're not permitted to receive any kind of answer, (Isaiah 45:11). Prayer can change all things, but you must engage God based on His word, (Mathew 7:7). Prayer grants access to divine intervention, (2 Chronicles 20:1-15; Exodus 14:14; Genesis 24:12-15; 1 Chronicles 4:10).
