Theme: Putting the Word to Work (Part 3)

God's word answers to our obedience of faith, and until the word is practiced it cannot deliver. Behind the working of the word is the individual subscribing to a lifestyle of spirituality (Romans 8 vs. 6).

WHAT IS SPIRITUALITY? Spirituality is the delightsome pursuit of God; it is having a heart for God and for the things of God.

You cannot have a heart for God and not make a mark in life. Spirituality entails living and walking according to the dictates of the scriptures (Psalm 1 vs. 1 - 3). Everything that works in life requires a right standing with God (Psalm 66 vs. 18; James 5 vs. 17). An individual is either carnal or spiritual; you cannot be neutral in life (1 Kings 18 vs. 21). You are either on God's side or the devil's (Matthew 6 vs. 24; Psalm 119 vs. 9, 11).

Walking in the consciousness of the word will put the believer above the devil's manipulation. The only cure for carnality is by embracing spirituality as a way of life. Also, spirituality is the cure for the curses of life (Romans 8 vs. 5).

Prayer and fasting void of spirituality is a waste of time and mere religiosity: it is the pursuit of godliness that empowers prayer and fasting to bring about the desire change. Spirituality exempts a believer from every harassment of the devil (James 1 vs. 22 - 25).

It is not just the words of scriptures that you know, but the word that is put to practice that works (Matthew 7 vs. 23 - 27). It is putting the word to work in truth and in deeds that counts for spirituality. For your prayer and fasting to be effective you must subscribe to spirituality as a way of life.

Spirituality empowers for supernatural intelligence. Surpassing intelligence resides in the realm of the spirit (Genesis 41 vs. 38; Daniel 1 vs. 8; John 7 vs. 15). The more you fear God the greater your access to realms of supernatural intelligence.
