How to Put the Word to Work – Part 2 A Message Delivered by Pastor Promise Omidiora At Thursday Chapel Service, November 23, 2017

The one who does the word is the one blessed by the word (James 1:21-25). It is engagement with the word that translates to testimonies. But it takes a spiritual man to receive a word from the Spirit of God and put it to work.

What Is Spirituality?

Spirituality is delightsome pursuit of scriptures. It is doing what God wants, taking steps according to the word of God and being like God. Everything that works requires alignment with the word of God. He who fears God has nothing else to fear; he who obeys God, will not bow to anything else (Psalm 66:18-19).

The one who receives the benefits of scriptures is the one who aligns himself with its dictates, (James 5:18-19). Elijah was a man whose life was committed to obeying God. When you pray and don't see answers, don't question God, question yourself. Every other thing in Christianity only answers to the prayers of a spiritual Christian, (1 John 5:14). It is only the spiritual that can locate the will of God.

Let us align ourselves with the word of God and everything else will fall into place. When your life does not align with the word, you become cheap prey to the devil. Without the help of God, man becomes helplessly helpless (1 Kings 18:1).

You must learn to discipline yourself when you are in the presence of God. You should not be distracted in the presence of God; you don't know when your own sent word will come. No one aligns himself with God and struggles in life.

Only the spiritual can be intellectually sound because your mind becomes quickened when you rub mind with God. Praying without spirituality is an act in futility. It is only the spiritual that can be outstanding in anything they do.

Being in the Church building is only a context, but imbibing the content of the Church is what makes a man. You have everything to gain being in Christ and everything to lose outside of Christ. The choice is yours!
