<u>Understanding How to Be Led By the Spirit – Part 2</u>

The leading of the spirit is very crucial to our journey with God, (Proverbs 14:12). Not every great destiny will be on a great light. It is not every open door that is the right door, (Proverbs 16:25). We need the leading hand of God to show us the way.
