Theme: Understanding the Wonders of Thanksgiving (Part 3)

Thanksgiving and praise are primary expectations of God from man, His creature: when you are in praise and thanksgiving, the presence of God is brought down (Psalm 22 vs. 3). When we give to God what He wants from us, He in turn gives to us what we desire of Him. Dwelling in praise attracts the visitation of the Almighty God, which also attracts the favour and honour of men.

God expects man to always return in thanksgiving for every blessing he experiences, if he so desire to get the blessings perfected and multiplied (Luke 17 vs. 12- 19; John 6 vs. 5 - 11). In an atmosphere of thanksgiving, supply will keep coming and multiplication will attend to what is left.

Nothing goes down in the hands of thanks givers, because it always bring down God's presence.

WHAT MUST WE THANK GOD FOR?

1. We must thank God for His wondrous work in our lives (Psalm 78 vs. 42; Psalm 28 vs. 5). Living a life of thanksgiving gives us victory in the battles of life without engaging directly in the battle.

It is important that we stop counting our losses, rather let us celebrate those things that we have. What we consider small should be the more reason we should give God thanks.
