It takes consciously exercising oneself, spiritually, for faith to be developed to withstand whatever issues that may confront one (1 Timothy 4 vs. 8; Hebrews 10 vs. 38; Romans 10 vs. 17). It takes faith to drive to fruition every vision.

Faith only grows, primarily, by hearing and understanding of the light of the truth from the word of God; because that one has heard something does not translates into understanding of the truth.

Building one's faith is not cheap talk, but hard work (Hebrews 4 vs. 10 - 12). God can only appear to man at the completion of his obedience to divine instructions.

HOW TO BUILD YOUR FAITH

- 1. By studying the word of God (1 Timothy 2 vs. 15).
- 2. By meditating on the word encountered (Psalm 119 vs. 97 100)
- 3. By praying in the Holy Ghost (Jude 1 vs. 20)

It takes an enduement with the Holy Ghost to access the deep things of God, which in turn helps us to build up our faith.
