God's Word Triggers Supernatural Breakthrough

To breakthrough means to get through. It means to make major progress, particularly in advancement against obstacles.

2Corinthians 2:14 says: "Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place".

How do you activate supernatural breakthrough through the Word?

- ❖ Find what God says about your breakthrough in the Word of God (2 Peter 1:2-4; Isaiah 14:24).
- Keep the promise in your heart, no matter what is happening. Keep it consistently before your eyes (Proverbs 4:21-22).
 Keep your eyes off the problems but on the promise.
- Go to God on the basis of His promise, not because of your needs or want (Hosea 14:2; Isaiah 14:21, Isaiah 43:26).
 Take His word back to Him by putting Him in remembrance (Matthew 8: 30-31).
- Resist the devil, particularly in your thoughts. Refuse to allow the devil to plant his thoughts in your mind (Philippians 4:8).
- Speak to the challenges and dare them to leave you (Proverbs 18:21).
 Speak to the mountain to clear out of your way.
- Make a definite decision. For instance, declare "I must not be defeated."
 (1John 5: 4-5)
- Praise God consistently in spite of circumstances (1Thessolonians 5: 6).
